The CMU Administration provided vehicles for the families of the victims in facilitating the claims of the casualties and also ferried them to their respective homes and morgue houses. 2. Visited all the families of the victims in their respective residential houses. The CMU Administration also visited the 11 wounded victims at the different hospitals where they were confined. | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provided vehicles to ferry students, faculty and staff in the visitation to the victims. 2. Provided vehicles to ferry students, faculty and staff from CMU to Valencia and CMU to Maramag. 3. Conducted Stress Debriefing Seminar to all students, faculty and staff who witnessed the incident. 4. Collected voluntary donations and solicitations from the different units, departments and colleges of the university. 5. Visited all the families of the victims in their respective residential houses. The CMU Administration also visited the 11 wounded victims at the different hospitals where they were confined. 6. Initiated an Indignation Rally and Ecumenical Mass for Peace participated by the CMU Community (Faculty, Staff and Students) held at the CMU Main Gate. 7. University activities such: University Christmas Party, University Faculty and Staff Palaro, Faculty Frolics and Students University Christmas Festival were suspended and the budget allocation for the said parties will be donated to the families of the victims (410, 000 pesos). 8. Prayer rally initiated by the students held at the CMU Main Gate. 9. Tightedened the security measures of the university through intensive checkpoints and inspections by the CMU Security Services. | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
